

George Nash wins the Boat Race

George Nash (K 2003-2008) and the rest of the Cambridge University crew upset the odds by coming from behind to win the 156th Boat Race in convincing fashion. George learnt how to row at Wincoll, under the guidance of James Bracey. In his final two years at the College George was part of the Wincoll crew that won a silver medal at the National Schools regatta. He also went on to compete for Great Britain at the Junior World Championships, where he won a gold medal in the coxless fours event. George is currently reading Engineering at St Catherine's College. He is expected to challenge for a seat in Olympic crews for 2012.
