Cornell Capa (1918-2008) visited Winchester College in February 1951 on an assignment for LIFE Magazine. The resulting story was published in April 1951. He photographed every angle of Wykehamical life in order to give as complete a portrayal as possible of "A Great British Public School". Cornell Capa had three major and interrelated careers: he was a member of the influential Magnum agency; he championed the work of his brother Robert Capa; and he was the founder and director of the International Center of Photography in New York.
