# THE TEACHER MUST NOT HELP THE CANDIDATE IN ANY WAY DURING THE PREPARATION OF THIS ORAL EXAMINATION

- Candidates should be given no more than five minutes to **prepare** the picture card.
- The oral exam should take about **6 or 7** but **no more than 10 minutes**.
- No dictionaries or reference materials are to be used by the candidate while he is preparing his role play.
- He may make notes during his preparation time, which he may refer to during the exam.
- Do the picture card first, followed by the general conversation.
- Please recast questions if candidates do not understand them at first.
- Please make sure that the candidate has an opportunity to use some form of the future tense.

There are two sections in this test: a picture card and a **two** to **three** minute conversation based on a list of **10** questions.

# Dictionaries are not allowed during the preparation of the role play or in the course of the examination.

The marking of the test will be done centrally at Winchester College. The picture card will be marked out of 10 (maximum 2 marks per task) and the conversation out of 16.

All candidates must be recorded and all recordings sent to Winchester College via e-mail, as an MP3 attachment to <a href="mailto:entrance@wincoll.ac.uk">entransfer (https://wetransfer.com/</a>) is the preferred method for large attachments. #### Section One: Picture Card

There is only **one** picture card. Candidates may have **five** minutes to prepare it. For reasons of assessment integrity, please ensure that the content of the card remains unknown to all candidates until the beginning of their preparation time and that candidates do not leave the examination room with a copy of the picture card.

#### Section Two: General Conversation

The general conversation will be the same for all candidates. Candidates will be asked **all** the **10** questions given on the sheet, in order. They should be encouraged to add as much detail to their answer as they can and to use as wide a variety of tenses as possible. Examiners should feel free to rephrase a question to help those candidates who do not immediately understand a question.

#### TEACHER'S NOTES PICTURE CARD

Thema: Ich, meine Familie und Freizeit

The approximate time for this part is 2 minutes.

Candidates may use any notes they have made during the preparation time. You begin by asking the candidate the first question: Was gibt es auf dem Foto? You then ask the remaining questions in order. You may rephrase the questions provided the same meaning is maintained and you may repeat the questions or paraphrase a question, which the candidate has not understood. Please allow candidates to develop their responses as well as they are able.

The additional questions which are not listed should relate to the overarching topic of me, my family and free time.
