Syllabus for the Greek Entrance Examination (First examination in 2021)

The grammar and vocabulary for the paper are those for <u>CE levels 1 and 2</u> (as revised May 2017). The paper is 30 minutes (Option 1) or 1 hour (Options 2 and 3).

Candidates should attempt:

either Option 1: Section A in 30 minutes

or Option 2: Sections A and B in 1 hour

or Option 3: Sections B and C in 1 hour.

•	5 English words for transliteration into Greek	[5%]
•	5 Greek words for translation and English derivatives	[10%]
•	5 Greek verbs for translation	[10%]
•	5 Greek sentences (c. 3 words) for translation	[15%]

Section B

CE level 1, question 2 grammar and vocabulary

•	6 Greek sentences for translation	[24%]
•	4 English sentences for translation into Greek	[16%]
•	5 English derivatives	[10%]

Section C

CE level 2 grammar and vocabulary

•	2 Greek sentences for translation	[10%]
•	2 English sentences for translation into Greek	[10%]

• Greek unseen translation (c. 100 words, + reasonable wider vocabulary) [30%]
