- 1. It is 11:05 on Monday morning. Imagine that your laptop has been with the school's IT department since last week so that it could receive an upgrade. When the device is returned to you, there are several email messages to respond to, and reminders that you have previously set for yourself. These are described here:
 - A. *Reminder*: for your Community Service commitment, you help to create an audio newspaper for the blind and partially sighted. You have been asked to write a description of a photograph to submit to the editor of the paper by the end of the week.
 - B. *Email*: some of your friends have asked you to join them at the opening of a new chocolate shop in town. The first 20 customers will receive a free sample of chocolate and your friends would like to meet there before the shop opens at 2:30pm today.
 - C. *Reminder*: to submit a History essay for marking. You have already written the essay but you think you can improve the concluding paragraph. The deadline is lunchtime today.
 - D. *Email*: from the captain of the house soccer team. He is isolating in the medical centre. He has asked you, the goalkeeper for the team, to select the soccer team for an interhouse soccer match this afternoon, and to let them all know. The match starts at 2pm.
 - E. *Reminder*: the school laundry collection is at 1:00pm today. You are wearing your last clean pair of socks so you need to make sure you put some in for washing today.
 - F. *Email*: from a good friend which reads "It's started again. He's being really nasty and making me feel so unhappy. What should I do?"
 - G. *Reminder*: to go into town to buy a birthday card for one of your friends it's his birthday tomorrow and you would like to be able to give him the card when he wakes up.
 - H. *Email*: from the Headmaster. He has received your request to start a Sustainability Society in the school; he thinks it is an interesting idea and would like to hear more about why you think it is important and what it could realistically achieve. He wants your thoughts as soon as possible.
 - a) Write down the order in which you are going to deal with these items (Note: there is no absolutely correct answer for this).
 - b) For the top 3 items on your list, explain why you have made them your top priority.
 - c) For these 3 items, explain how you are going to deal with these tasks.

No matter what you indicated in question 1, you should now complete questions 2 & 3

2. Complete task A from the above list. You should describe the photo below, so that it can be recorded for the audio newspaper.
