An **Old Wykehamist** seeking or offering advice;

A current Wykehamist in VIth Book;

A **Parent** who is prepared to offer advice;

TJs and Protégés

You should be familiar with the terms Tégé (abbreviated to TJ) and Protégé used to describe a guide and their apprentice in their first few weeks at Win Coll. These uniquely Wykehamical terms fit well with the spirit of Wykeham Links and will be used in place of Mentor and Mentee throughout.

Sign up as a TJ

We encourage all OWs and Parents to sign up as potential advisers on Wykeham Links. You can control what you sign up for and whether to make contact when approached. You will be able to access a user guide when the site goes live.

'Ask a TJ' is where pupils will seek advice.
